Dr Pengiran Hishamuddin is the Head of the Disease Control Division at the Ministry of Health, Brunei Darussalam. He obtained his medical degree from the University of Nottingham and Masters in Public Health from Emory University. Currently he works mainly on public health preparedness for emerging infectious diseases and pandemic influenza. Having been appointed as a Deputy Secretary in the Ministry of Health Pandemic Influenza Preparedness Secretariat, he is looking at ways to improve collaboration and involvement of the non-health and private sector in pandemic influenza preparedness. At the regional level he works together with various organizations in emerging infectious diseases and pandemic influenza matters, especially with ASEAN. He is also an advisor for the Australian Research Centre for Emerging Diseases and an adjunct lecturer at the Institute of Medicine, University of Brunei Darussalam. In 2004 he became the first Fulbright scholar from Brunei Darussalam.
