

Information Sheet Concerning Nomination of Experts for APEC Marine Sustainable Development Report 2

Key points concerning the nomination

1. Open from 19 April 2017 until 19 May 2017;
2. Open to member economies and relevant non-members;
3. Experts with backgrounds in a) marine management and policy especially in marine pollution control, marine ecosystem conservation and resources management, ocean and climate change and sustainable fisheries management; b) APEC operations are welcomed.

Role and responsibilities of the core expert group

1. develop the general report by setting outline, collecting useful data and information, drafting and reviewing;
2. have sufficient communication during the formulation process of the report through workshops, informal meetings, tele-meetings and emails;
3. work in collaboration with APEC Marine Sustainable Development Centre to finalize and publish the final report;
4. design the questionnaire to collect relevant information from member economies for the purpose of drafting AMSD Report 2.
5. work on other issues concerning the developing and updating of the report;

Expected Activities in 2017

A 2-day workshop will be convened in 2017 for shaping the theme, chapter structure and outlines of the report. Date of the workshop is to be determined after the establishment of core expert group.

The activities in 2018 and following years will be arranged according to the drafting process with reference to the work plan in the information paper.
